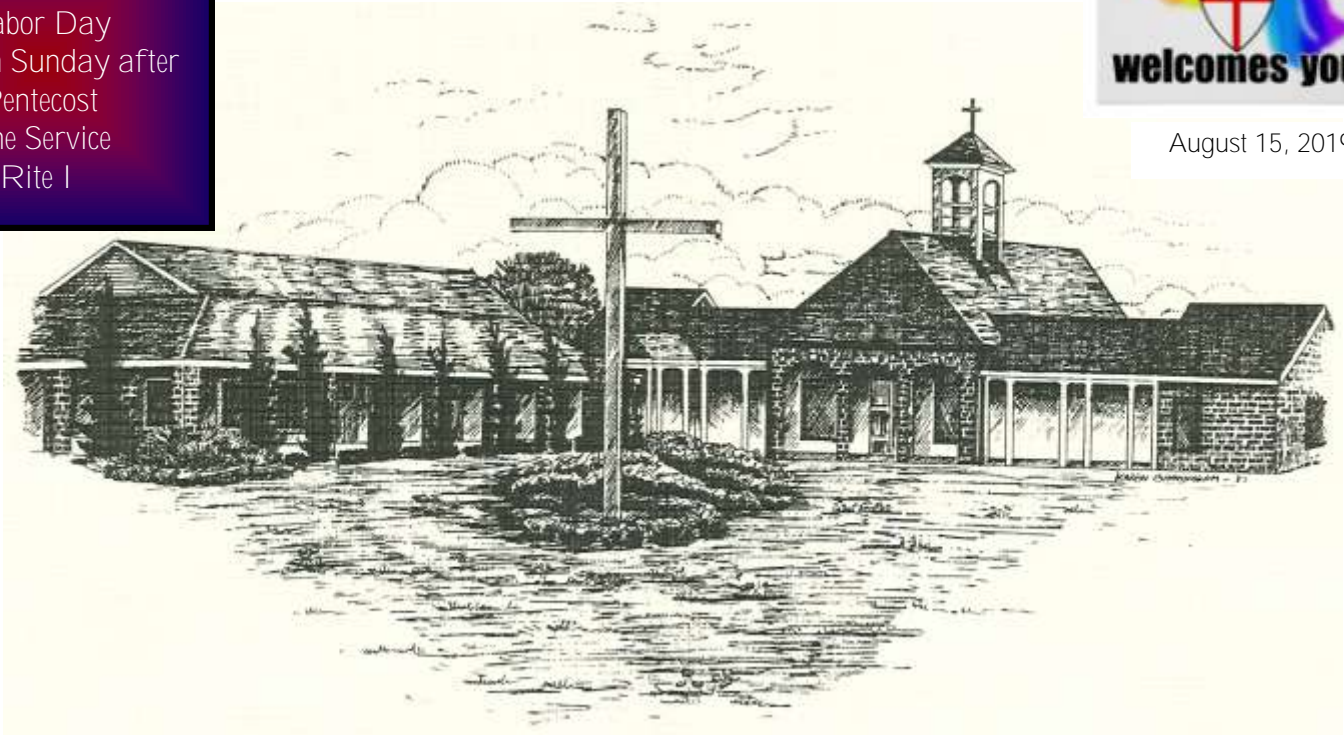

Celebration of Women's Ministries

"Creation Considered: Encountering Creatures as Spiritual Practice"

There will be a Celebration of Women's Ministries held at Camp Hardtner on September 20–21, 2019. This is a time for numerous diverse ministries to come together and celebrate in the name of our Lord and Savior. The ministries of the Diocesan Daughters of the King, Episcopal Church Women, and Altar Guild women will hold meetings; and our guest speaker, Mother Betty Jo Kauffman, Archdeacon of the Diocese and Deacon at Christ Episcopal Church, (Bastrop) will share some of her photographs, while talking about "how and why interacting with creation IS a spiritual practice". Spiritual Direction will be offered by Mother Rowena White, St. Mark's Cathedral, Shreveport.

The weekend will begin on Friday evening, September 20, with registration between 4 P.M. and 6 P.M. Then, there will be a Meet and Greet Social and dinner. Mother Bette will also present us with her first presentation.

Mother Bette invites participants who would like to join her for a walk before breakfast on Saturday morning (sneakers recommended). Sat. registration will be from 8-9 AM. 9:00 breakfast will be followed by the E.C.W. meeting. After a short break, the D.O.K. meeting will begin. The last meeting will be the Altar Guild meeting. Please come and meet with ladies from throughout the diocese. Be inspired by some great ideas from other parishes and feel free to share what's going on in your parish. All women are encouraged to attend any or all meetings. *You do not have to be a member to attend the meetings.*

Early registration is suggested, and registrants will receive a detailed schedule of the Celebration weekend. We hope to see each of you at our annual celebration weekend! We are going to have a glorious time!!

The cost for the weekend is \$75 (covers a night of lodging, three meals, snacks and the speaker). If you prefer to drive down for Saturday only, the cost is \$25 (covers the session and two meals). Private lodging is \$95 (covers a night of lodging, three meals, snacks and the speaker), space permitting.

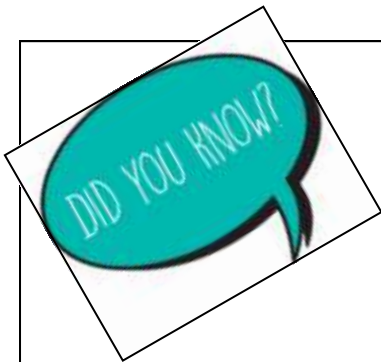

Join us on August 25th for our Rally Day celebration! Everyone is welcome to participate.

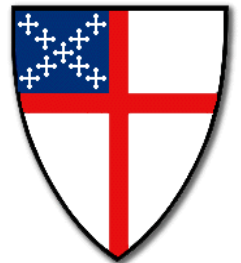
The vestry meeting for the month of August will take place on the 25th, at 12:30.
